# October 10-11, 2019 7th World Congress on Targeting Mircobiota 2019, Krakow, Poland

During 2019 7th World Congress of Targeting Microbiota in Krakow, **NUTRISHIELD** project was presented by our colleagues from REM Analytics. During the meeting, we discussed how nutrition could modulate the microbiome composition, improve health and prevent diseases. The effect of the personalised nutritional approach on gut microbiome composition and clinical outcome was underlined. However, to provide health solutions

based on microbiome, accurate analyses are necessary. REM Analytics will provide the comprehensive and quantitative microbiome profile for NUTRISHIELD project.

### September 26, 2019 1st NUTRISHIELD Workshop – Hospital La Fe, Valencia, Spain

The 1st **NUTRISHIELD** workshop, co-located with the 3rd NUTRISHIELD project meeting, took place on 26th September 2019 at the Health Research Institute La Fe, Hospital La Fe, Valencia, Spain. The workshop which was followed by 40 participants on site and an additional 40 remote/online participants evolved around the importance of optimized nutrition for infants and lactating mothers.

Two invited speakers provided the latest findings in advances in neonatal nutrition (Dr Miguel Saenz de Pipaon) and the importance of breast feeding towards ensuring optimum infant nutrition (Dr Salome Laredo Ortiz).

This was followed by presentations from NUTRISHIELD partners which presented the overall project vision towards personalised nutrition and the technical means under development in order to foster the wide adoption of fact-based personalised nutrition in a non-intrusive, intuitive and user-friendly way.






#### June 23-27, 2019 15th Annual Conference of the Metabolomics Society-The Hague, Netherlands
